Maths

(You must complete these activities)

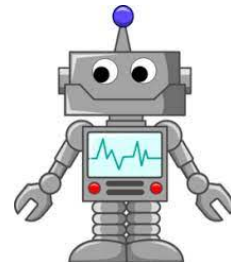
- Use items around the house to build a 3D shape model and name the 3D shapes

English - Reading

(You must complete these activities)

- Read books and answer questions on Bug Club as often as possible. The books have been set to suit you.
- Read stories at home and discuss the clues e.g. I think the character feels... because it says...
- Practise reading out loud using expression. Think about how the punctuation can help.

English - Writing

(You must complete these activities)

- Practise writing sentences that have **specific** noun phrases. For example - The giant, gnarly **oak** tree grew in Astley park.
- Tell us about your activities over a weekend. Practise writing sentences using time connectives eg: **When** we had baked the cakes, we gave them to Grandma and Grandad. (You could also use *while, as, before, after*)
- Practise your spellings each week.

History - Changes within living memory

- Ask your grandparents what their favourite toy was, draw it and label the differences with toys today
- Can you make a toy timeline from 1940 to today?

R.E. - Why is church special for Christians?

- Can you design a new church?
What do you think a new 21st Century church should look like?
What should be inside this new church? (There must be some kind of font and altar.)
- Collect pictures of different churches in the Chorley area.

Computing

- Log onto Purple Mash and have a go at 2explore and 2beat
- You will record simple melodies by clicking on the instruments and have go at making rhythms and following the pulse.
