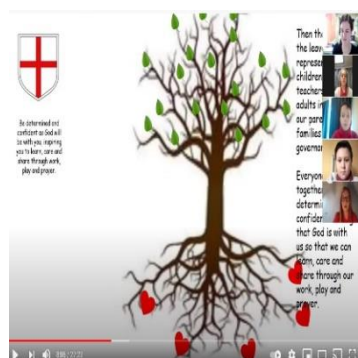
Our Vision in the curriculum
