

Maths

(You must complete this activity)

- Complete the weekly MyMaths activities.
- Practise your times tables. This half term, we will be focusing on 2's and 3's. Spend one week learning your 2 times tables up to 2×6 . Spend the second week learning from 2×6 up to 2×12 and then spend the third week practising them all before moving onto the 3 times tables. These will be tested every week (like spellings) so that you can keep up to date with how your child is progressing with their times tables.

Art

- Research a Famous British Artist and try and mimic their work in a piece of your own.

Music

- Practise playing your ukulele every week. Think about what you have been taught in your weekly lessons. Record yourself and upload in onto Seesaw.

English

- You will be sent weekly spellings to learn every week which will be test on the following Friday.
- Read your school reading book every day to an adult. Remember to record what you read in your reading record to earn certificates.
