English - Writing

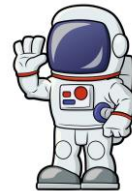
(You must complete these activities)

R.E.

- Can you draw a picture inspired by your favourite story from the Bible?

- Imagine you are on the Apollo 11 flight to the Moon. Record a verbal diary on Seesaw about how you felt before the rocket took off, what it was like to travel through Space and what it felt like to land and walk on the Moon.

Science

 - What would its off-spring look like?
 - Would it need to do exercise to stay healthy?
