

# Home Learning Menu – Class 1 and 2



## Maths

(Core activity)

- Practice practical addition (work with numbers your child is comfortable with), perhaps tell a number story i.e. If Mrs Towers has 3 sweets and Miss Glover has 5, how many are there altogether? Challenge 'who has more sweets?'
- Number formation

## Reading

(Core activity)

- **PLEASE** Read your phonics book or home reader with an adult every day – remember we have reading certificates!
- Can you stop before the end to make a prediction?

## Writing

(Core activity)

- Can you write some CVC words? Could you help write a shopping list, birthday card etc.

## R.E.

(Core activity)

*Our RE unit this term is 'Stories Jesus Heard'.*

- Do you like listening to stories?
- What are your favourite stories?
- Where and when do you hear stories?
- Who tells you stories?

## Communication and Language

(Topic activity)

- Play *10 clues*. This activity works well when the children can physically see the item you are describing. The aim of the game is to guess the object in the least number of clues- the clues to get progressively easier. For example, the first 3 clues for a pencil may be: You can hold me in your hand, I can be sharp, you use me to draw etc.

### Try your best to:

- Complete all the core activities above (*Maths, Reading, Writing and R.E.*).
- Select **one other topic activity** to complete. You can choose which activities you find the most interesting or be creative and generate your own!

## Understanding the world

(Topic activity)

- Can you show your understanding of the seasons? - This could be through discussion, list of clothing for the various seasons, season wheel etc).

(Topic activity)

- Children to create a piece of Space art. This could be painted, collaged, a model, etc of the solar system and encourage your child to discuss Space and the planets.
