



Home Learning Menu – Class 1 and 2

Maths

(Core activity)

- Provide children with some form of counting objects i.e. counter, cheerios, blocks etc. Introduce flashcards with numbers 1 to 10 (these can be written on a piece of paper or post it note), and ask children to sort the objects into groups according to the number on the card.
- Practice number formation using patter (see attached).

Reading

(Core activity)

- Read your phonics book or home reader with an adult every day and talk about the story together. Can you give reasons why you like or dislike the story?
- Can you spot our new learning while reading your Phonics book?

Writing

(Core activity)

- Look at letters (graphemes) s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r. Can you say the sounds (phonemes)? Can you write them? Use the handwriting patter sheets to help you form the letters. Focus on starting and finishing in correct places and with correct pencil grip.

R.E.

(Core activity)

- Who are special people to you?
- Read the nativity story and talk about the importance of Jesus' birth. You could create a nativity scene using lego, playdough etc to help you retell the story.

Understanding the world

(Topic activity)

- Talk about celebrations you have shared with your family and friends (birthdays, Christenings, weddings, Bonfire night, Christmas etc). What do we celebrate and how do we celebrate it?

Communication and Language

(Topic activity)

- Sound Treasure Hunt. Using the sounds we have learnt in Phonics s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r.
- Children to listen to the sounds and locate objects, discussing what they found and the sounds they heard.

- Complete all the core activities above (**Maths, Reading, Writing and R.E.**).
- Select **one other topic activity** to complete. You can choose which activities you find the most interesting or be creative and generate your own!
