Maths

(Core activity)

- Have a shape hunt around your house – focus on square rectangles, circles, triangles and oblong rectangles

Reading

(Core activity)

- Record yourself reading or talking about your favourite story and why you like it.
- Don't forget to read your school phonics book!

Writing

(Core activity)

- Practise writing tricky words i.e. I, no, go, to, into, the, me, we, be, she, he, was, my, her, all, are, like
- Write an Easter Card.
- Write a sentence to match the pictures on the back of the homework menu.

R.E.

(Core activity)

- Key Questions to start a discussion - What is love? Where is love? Who do you love? Who loves you? How do you/they show that love?
- How did Jesus show that He loved us?

(Topic activity)

Farming

- Questions to start a discussion - Are all farms the same? Why do we need farms? What are your favourite foods? Where does that food come from?

Communication and Language

(Topic activity)

- **I went to the shops...**take it in turns to choose something you bought from the shop and the next person adds to what the previous person said. You could add challenge by picking a particular category or going through the alphabet.

- Select **one other topic activity** to complete. You can choose which activities you find the most interesting or be creative and generate your own!
